Synopsis of Lecture: For this event, Drs. Inglis and Pashagumskum will describe some efforts by museum specialists and First Nations in Canada to collaborate on museums and cultural centres.

About the Speakers:

Dr. Stephen Inglis teaches curatorial studies and Asian Art at Carleton University in Ottawa. He is the former Director General of Research and Collections at the Canadian Museum of Civilization (now History) and former Executive Director of the Aanischaaukamikw Cree Cultural Institute in Eeyou Istchee (northern Quebec).

Dr. Sarah Pashagumskum is originally from the community of Chisasibi, in the northern part of the Cree territory, Eeyou Istchee. She is a strong contributor to the

preservation of First Nations culture and history as well as to education. Dr. Pashagumskum is Director of Annishaaukamikw Cree Cultural Institute and currently the Chair of the Cree School Board.
